General Rules

September 17th, 2011

The following rules will be enforced.

- * No alcohol period.
- * For the safety of all onlookers especially small children NO CANDY or ITEM can be tossed from the parade route. Only walkers may pass out candy or items.
- * Only vehicle participants are allowed in the staging area, and need to report any breakdowns **immediately**.
- * Vehicles, **No burnouts**. You will be asked to leave the line and a Sheriff could ticket you.
- * Participants are not to leave any entry unit unattended.
- * All participants riding on any moving vehicle should be anchored, seat belted and/or have something to hold on to.
- * Late applications accepted subject to space availability and will be lined up as they are received. So get your applications in early!

Check in is from 9 am - 10:30 am.

Come to the parade check in area to receive your parade entry number. Parade check in entrance is at the intersection of Washington St. and Rose St. Vacant lot by Community Center see the map below for staging area, parade route and parade exit staging areas. Look for tent and balloons!

Parade begins at 11:00am. Parade will enter on HWY from Roberts Rd. follow HWY 101 through Quilcene. Parade will end at the intersection of HWY 101 & Center Rd (US Bank). Center Rd will be closed from 11-12:00 pm. There will be volunteers at the end of the parade showing where you need to exit. Any assist vehicles can be parked along the shoulder of Center Rd before the parade for float/participant pick up after parade.
